Case workers serve as counselors, coaches and resource coordinators. Whether your goals include education, employment, housing or something more, a case worker provides invaluable support.



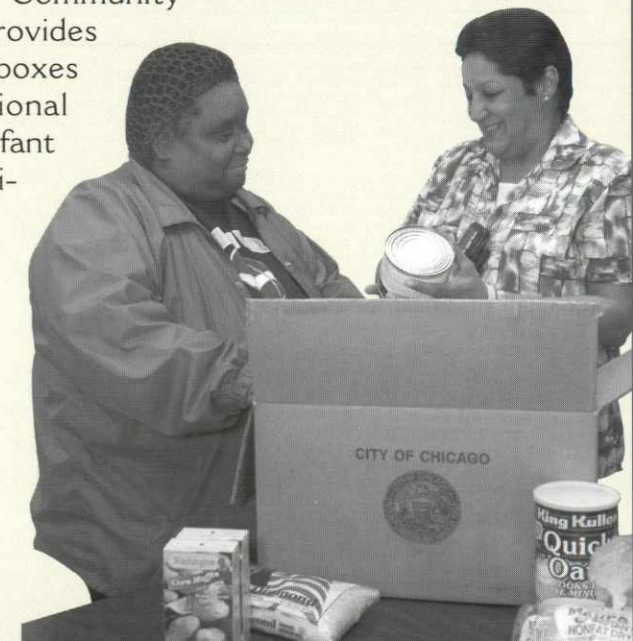
Health Services

Discover how you can access...

- **Shelter and Housing:**
Emergency shelter options, low-income and supportive housing programs, homeowner resources.
- **Rental Assistance:**
Emergency funds help city residents in crisis pay a month's rent.
- **Domestic Violence Assistance:**
Counseling, housing and legal assistance for victims of domestic violence.
- **Health Services:**
Immunizations, lead and school physicals.
- **Job Training and Placement:**
Skills development, resumes, job searches, interview scheduling and preparation.
- **Children and Youth Support Services:**
Referrals for subsidized, licensed child care and programs for older youth.
- **Emergency Food:**
Nutritional basic food items for residents in crisis including infant formula.
- **Clothing:**
Free, gently used articles of clothing, as available.
